



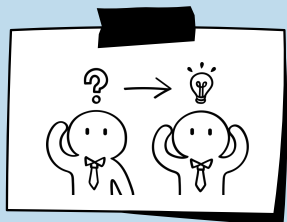
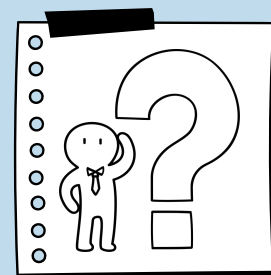
WHAT IS

Family Engagement

Family engagement is a shared responsibility in which schools and other community agencies and organizations are committed to reaching out to engage families in meaningful ways and in which families are committed to actively supporting their children's learning and development. (NAFSCE, 2010)

What does family engagement do?

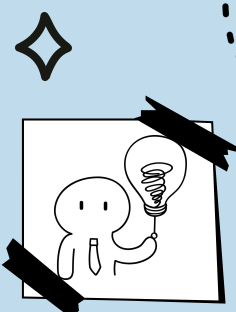
Family engagement supports learning and development in a variety of spaces: schools, learning centers, homes... Supporting a child's learning is **FAMILY ENGAGEMENT!**
