Building Words

What can you build with letters?

- Make 5 different words
- Make as many words as you can using 7 letters
- Race against a partner to see who can make the most words using the letters

What if....

What if you could rewrite how a book ends?

Create a new ending for one of your favorite books. Share the new ending with a family member!

Anagrams

Time to mix it up!

Create a word with the letters.

Mix up the tiles/paper and pass them to another player. Have the player try and spell your word! Can they figure it out?

Telling Stories

Telling stories is a great way to share as a family. Pick a question and tell your story. Take turns as a family!

- Tell a story about your first day of school!
- Tell a story about your favorite birthday celebration!
- Tell a story about the day you learned to...ride a bike!



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Sight Words

Use the sight word worksheet to practice spelling!

I Spy

Play I Spy with letters!
With a partner, choose a letter.
Find and point to something in the room and say: "I spy something that starts with the letter...".
Have your partner guess what the object is and then spell it using the letters!

Story Time

Time to mix it up!

Make a word with the letters, like "dog" or "mop".

Make up a story using that word as the main "character".

Tell your story to a family member or create a story together!

Room Read Aloud

Read a book with a family member (picture books are great!) and take turns finding the objects related to the story in the room around you!
